Fashion designers dress one common frame in various ways. The leather has been bent and draped over both straight and curved shapes to create depth and volume to the chair. English saddlery has been a major inspiration in developing the hardware and shape of the dress on this frame.







The collection by Alessandro Zambelli comprises a series of storage furniture that include a small cabinet, a dry bar, a console and a coffee table, where the metal inlays remind of those traditionally found in Art Deco wooden furniture, adding a new element of character and prestige. The linear essentiality of the forms, which is reflected in each element of the collection, is enriched by the presence of precious superficial decors that are juxtaposed through inlays: small metal oxidised plates animate the surface of each storage element with their refined alternation of delicate geometrical motifs. The oxidation process brings a unique mutation of the surface itself, enriched by a whole variety of shades and gradation.








The "echo" table pushes the material limits of metal and wood to imagine an intangible reality. The grain of wood tells its history, and by using a technique of exposing the hardwood (season of winter) and embedded metal into the lines of the softwood (season of summer), each growth creates an elusive boundary between the two materials.

The objectivity further enhanced by the lightness and thinness in the profile of both materials. Beauty and inspiration are found all around us. The table legs reference the shape generated by the spilling of water.

The variation in the shapes of the table top resembles that of stones organically formed by sea current. Enacting the activity and motion which would happen around a table. The colours allude to the subtle shades of a sunrise, created in three metal: aluminium, copper, and brass.



The design of the Lithosphere Coffee Table takes its inspiration from the different layers of the Earth's crust and upper mantle. The table juxtaposes four stone slabs sourced from specific locations in Italy. The slabs are divided into four concentric elements, these nestle seamlessly inside each other, as in a Matryoshka. The sixteen

elements can then be separated and stacked in differing combinations, producing four material variations of the table. The design was carefully considered to maximise the use of each slab. By intermingling the four stones, variety is created, whilst simultaneously minimising waste.



Coulee uses two heavyweight pieces, creating a stable structure by joining complimenting geometry where the table becomes a singular mass/volume/sculpture.









The Veiled is a collection of tables and trays made of marble with a graphical pattern inspired by an ancient statue. It experiments with the dichotomy between a silk and soft looking surface for a hard material like marble. The effect of light and dark-coloured marble in stripes is both graphic and illusional, as the pattern catches your eye and invites you to touch. The collection of tables combine contemporary techniques and aesthetics with the traditional way of making inlays.

Remetaled nesting table is a series of two tables, consisting a layering composition of different types of metal sheets. Layering brings depth in a object, offers room for surprise, and gives the metal an innovative materiality. By nesting metal sheets in a vertical direction, a new layered texture originates, giving the metal a new materiality.

By turning the candleholder 180 degrees, the user will experience a different composition.



Full bowls are on the point of overflowing.
The precious marble is crafted into a form
that makes a liquid form solid. They function
normally as bowls only sharing the expected
volume with the object itself. This makes them
ideal for displaying small amounts of beautiful
food or objects.

Each Full bowl is hand turned in Italy from marble. Variations in grain and colouring make each bowl unique.







Flower Vessel

The object is multifunctional and allows the user to play with it and its own function: it can be used as tableware sculpture, a glass holder as well as a vase when the wine bottle is not nit.

The marble discs can slide off from the brass bar and reassembled by people in different ways, therefore everyone can create their own unique piece playing with the nuances and the patterns inherent in every block of marble.









Wine Cooler

Materials: Carrara Marble.

The project takes advantages from the natural thermic qualities of marble and inspiration from the long-held tradition that Carrara marble has with food.

The product can maximise the use of marble wastes as each piece comes straight from the marble coring cylinders discarded by the industrial productions.







The Wave Fruit Holder

The fruit bowl is assembled by simple shape of marble pieces with abstract composition, which creates a feeling of natural aesthetic.

Banfi Wine & Design is an artistic project that celebrates the exclusive character of Banfi's signature wine: the Brunello di Montalcino Castello Banfi.

The project is born from the collaboration of Banfi with MOS for the first editon of "MOS Designer Residencies" where six designers (Alessandro Zambelli, Nina Cho, Olga Bielawska, Tim Vanlier, Tomas Gabzdil Libertiny, UUfie) were called to design a wine label for a special limited edition of Brunello di Montalcino Castello Banfi 2011.

The project involves the production of customized wooden boxes, each containing six numbered bottles of 750 ml., with a label designed by each artist.

The designers were inspired by their personal reinterpretation of the official label of Castello Banfi Brunello di Montalcino, driven in their work by the six pillars on which is founded the Banfi philosophy: Territory, Tradition, Innovation, Quality, Passion and Sustainability. Product Details:


