Finding inspiration in planetary orbits, whose gravitationally curved trajectories drive the lines and shapes of the designs. Constructed from thin square metal rods, the designs play with circles and straight lines to create pieces that are delicate, light but complex. The pieces are manufactured from 12 mm square steel rods, which are laser-cut and welded to form combinations of semi circles and straight lines. Fabricated in either dark chocolate bronze or a brass coated steel.





# Orbit Dining Chair



The "echo" table pushes the material limits of metal and wood to imagine an intangible reality. The grain of wood tells its history, and by using a technique of exposing the hardwood (season of winter) and embedded metal into the lines of the softwood (season of summer), each growth creates an elusive boundary between the two materials. The colours allude to the subtle shades of a sunrise, created in three metal: aluminium, copper, and brass.

Luminarie is an expressive study of lighting as a poetic object, inspired by the designer's memories of lights at religious festivals in southern Italy. The Luminarie lighting mobile uses LED technology applied not to a functional lamp but to a sentimental, ethereal and poetic work of art. Tactile, playful, illusory and mobile, Luminarie are very light-weight, ethereal structures; handcrafted in Italy from copper and with micro LEDs.

Clean Sweep by Umut Yamac design Umut Yamac

Clean Sweep is a sculptural time piece composed of a large brass disc which rotates very slowly down a vertical stem, making one revolution over a period of approximately 12 hours. The brass disc is oxidised with a rich, coloured patina that is gradually cleaned away by brushes within the armature as the disc rotates on its journey downwards. Concentric rings of cleaned brass contrast with the patinated surface, offering a continually changing canvas and a different way to think about the passage of time.





# Spun Halo pendant

Spun Halo is a new light sculpture which explores the potential of thread, a normally invisible material, to create and define volumes of light. Consisting of over 600 meters of thread, Spun Halo has been hand woven to create two intersecting volumes, each suspending a ring of light of light in mid-air. The criss-crossing threads create what appears to be a new volume within the light, and the effect of their layering is a large-scale interference pattern, or moire, which creates the illusion of movement as you move around the light.



The Veiled is a collection of tables made of marble with a graphical pattern inspired by an ancient statue. It experiments with the dichotomy between a silk and soft looking surface for a hard material like marble. The effect of light and dark-coloured marble in stripes is both graphic and illusional. The pattern catches your eye and invites you to touch. It combines a modern technique and aesthetic with the traditional way of making inlays.








# Round Large Coffee Table - Metal







# Round Large Dinner Table - 3 Legs Marble
