MORGHEN is a multidisciplinary studio that works on the boundaries between design, art and craftsmanship. We rely on techniques passed on by the artisan heritage mixed with


experimentation and contemporary materials.

Every single piece is conceived, developed and hand crafted in a carefully renovated old carpenter's shop located in the Milanese Bovisa district.


Every single piece evolves from and assimilates previous theoretical and practical research.

### **CASCADE**

Cascade tells about the encounter of technique with improvisation, of technology with action. Cascade floats, while light paths flow softly underneath her brass body. Each light path is hand shaped, resulting in trajectories that are always different and surprising. As in a carillon that delivers reflection and refractions tirelessly.

## DOUBLE CASCADE

Double cascade freezes in time and space the motion of her little sister. It generates a closed declination of it, in form of a well-defined and univocal shape. In a constant play of balance and imbalance, the two ends of the lamp are both generative and receptive elements, two opposites linked together eternally.



### **CALYPSO**

The Calypso family stems from the investigation of the transmitting properties of an everyday usage material. Silicone is well known for its multiple qualities, whilst its relationship with light is still to be researched.

By using a pmma profile, the hidden led light is focused and directed towards the silicone diffuser, which in return lights up

with soft shades of warm light.

The result is a unique entity that glows gently, apparently

generating light itself.

As the interplay between the two can be modified and adjusted, the viewer is called to discover an always new causal link

between shapes and materials.

It is an indirect light, which hides its driver in the steel base, the only element that anchors it to the ground and from which she can't disengage. A continuous play of tension and equilibrium.










### NOVEMBER TANGO






